



## COMMON ADMISSIONS TO SIX NEW IIMS

The six new IIMs at Ranchi, Rohtak, Raipur, Udaipur, Trichy & Kashipur are conducting the Common Admissions for the PGDM for the 2012-14 batch.

The process for the same is as follows:

1. Individual IIMs will prepare a shortlist based on their individual criteria. The combined list of candidates to be considered for further processing will be prepared by coordinating IIM, namely, IIM Ranchi.
2. From the combined list, students called for interviews by IIM Calcutta, IIM Lucknow, IIM Kozhikode will be set aside. The remaining candidates will be called for a common Personal Interview & Written Analysis (PI & WAT).
3. The PI & WAT score for candidates set aside from the common shortlist will be obtained from the respective older IIMs from which they got the interview calls. Those who have been called by more than one older IIM will have their PI & WAT score averaged for further processing. If for some reasons, anyone called by older IIMs happens to miss the interview(s) will not be eligible to attend the common PI & WAT process of the six new IIMs. Those called by the older IIMs, but not in our list will not be considered for admission to six new IIMs.
4. The candidates shortlisted for any or all of the six new IIMs will get their log-in credentials to the common admissions website ([www.iimranchi.ac.in/6iims\\_admissions](http://www.iimranchi.ac.in/6iims_admissions)) to know about their status. Candidates will also be given an option to opt out of the process before 31<sup>st</sup> Jan 2012. Those who undergo the PI & WA process can also change the centres and dates subject to availability of slots on or before 5<sup>th</sup> Feb 2012.
5. After normalizing PI & WA scores, across panels, across centers and across different IIMs a combined merit list will be prepared for the entire lot of students to be considered for admission to the six new IIMs.
6. The individual member institution will take the normalized PI & WA score of the candidates shortlisted by them and combine it with scores for other criteria -- CAT score, Profile score and any other score to make their own individual merit list to make final offer to the candidates.
