Kushankur Dey is an Assistant Professor at the Indian Institute of Management Lucknow and joined the institute in September 2019. He has held the Centre for Food & Agribusiness Management Chairmanship of IIM Lucknow from September 21, 2020, to September 20, 2022. Before joining IIM Lucknow, he served on the faculty of IIM Bodh Gaya, XIM University, and TAPMI, Manipal, for about five years.

He is a Fellow in Rural Management (equivalent to a PhD) from the Institute of Rural Management Anand. He is a Postdoctoral Fellow of the Centre for Management in Agriculture, Indian Institute of Management Ahmedabad. He has more than 20 peer-reviewed research articles to his credit.
