Bansal, A., King, D. R., Meglio, O. (2022). Acquisitions as programs: The role of sensemaking and sensegiving, International Journal of Project Management, 40(3), 278-289.

Abstract: The intersection of program management and acquisition research remains undeveloped. Within both research domains there is limited recognition of how senior and project managers frame change and influence the meaning construction of others in complex and ambiguous situations. We investigate how sensemaking and sensegiving alternate within an acquisition program during ten Indian acquisitions. Our resulting model high lights how sensemaking and sensegiving interface and blend across different projects (e.g., functional or task based) to build shared meaning and maintain business continuity. Viewing acquisitions as programs, consisting of interrelated projects, disentangles how senior managers create shared meaning. Additional implications for research and management practice are identified

Bansal, A. (2022). Managing Entitled Employees: An Empirical Investigation of Luxury Establishments. Journal of Hospitality and Tourism Management. 50, 298-308.

Abstract: Entitlement presents significant negative implications for individuals, teams, and organizations. Manifesting as high levels of aggression, conflict with managers and peers, and ill-treatment of clients and customers, entitled behavior is detrimental to hospitality establishments. Based on positive psychology, this study investigates the role of psychological capital in eliminating employee psychological entitlement in the context of luxury hotels. The survey data, collected from a sample of 313 mid-level professionals from such hotels, were analyzed using AMOS 26.0.0. The research findings unravel the indirect effect of psychological capital on psychological entitlement, exhibiting the mediating role of psychological ownership and job embeddedness and the moderating role of the nature of work (full-time versus temporary) and work experience. The study finds that employees possessing a greater sense of ownership of the organization and substantial self-worth that reduces psychological entitlement are likely a better fit in their job and the organization.

Kavita Chaddha presented her paper "A New and Innovative Model of Academic Libraries for Higher Education Institutes in India - A Case Study" at the 10th International Library Information and Professionals Summit (ILIPS 2022) conference, held from 20-21 May 2022 at the Institute of Economic Growth, Delhi.

The paper has been published in the conference proceedings "Resilience, Reflection and Innovation in Library Services and Practices" Chapter 16, Pages 193-231, 2022, published by Bookwell publications and edited by Dr Parveen Babbar, Dr P K Jain, Dr Debal Kar, Dr Dinesh Kumar.


