On behalf of the Director of the Indian Institute of Management, Lucknow (IIML contractors having a valid Electrical Contractor License issued by the competent authority are hereby invited to quote their rates for **“Electrical and networking work for repair and renovation work of the Placement Office”**, Prabandh Nagar, IIM Road, Lucknow, as per the RFQ.

The work shall be completed within **50 DAYS** from the date of the award of the work/letter of intent, or acceptance of the work. The RFQ document should be signed in ink on each page, and any cutting or overwriting should be signed accordingly. All the attached papers should be submitted duly signed by the Bidder.

The conditions of this notice and those mentioned in General Conditions, Special Conditions, and BOQ enclosed will be binding on the Bidder. The Director, Indian Institute of Management, Lucknow, reserves the right to reject one or more RFQs without assigning any reason. No claim whatsoever shall be entertained on this account.

The validity of the RFQ shall be 90 days from the date of opening of RFQs. Bidders incorporating additional conditions, discounts, and rebates are liable to be rejected.

Bidders are advised to **physically inspect the site and familiarize themselves with the prevailing site conditions, accessibility, approach roads, material handling requirements, and other working conditions** before submitting their quotations.

No claim for any **deviation, variation, or revision in rates or contractual conditions** shall be entertained after award of the work on the grounds of ignorance or inadequate knowledge of the site conditions. Bidders shall be deemed to have satisfied themselves regarding all site-related conditions and requirements prior to quoting their rates.

The **last date and time for submission of rates is 30.08.2026 up to 1500 Hrs.** Any submission received after the stipulated date and time shall not be accepted. The **Technical Bid will be opened on 30.08.2026 at 1530 Hrs.**

Bidders are therefore advised to ensure timely submission of their quotations and to undertake a thorough site inspection before quoting.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. NAME OF WORK

Electrical and networking work for repair and renovation work of the Placement Office at IIM Lucknow, at an estimated cost of **Rs. 1,60,633.00 (incl. GST)**.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work covers the complete electrical and networking works for the renovation of the Placement Office (two rooms) at IIM Lucknow, which are already internally electrified with false ceiling and light fittings in position, including but not limited to:

- a) Point wiring for light, fan, exhaust fan and call bell points in surface/recessed medium class PVC conduit, with modular type switch, modular plate and suitable GI box, complete with earthing as required.
- b) Shifting / re-positioning of the existing light and fan points in the existing false ceiling to suit the revised furniture and workstation layout, including re-drawing / extending the existing wiring, re-fixing of the existing fittings, making good the false ceiling cut-out and ceiling finish, testing and re-commissioning.
- c) Twin-control light point wiring for total shutdown of all lights and fans of a room from outside the door.
- d) Power-plug wiring and circuit / sub-main wiring of various cable sizes, complete with earth wire, in surface/recessed medium class PVC conduit, serving the 20 workstation socket positions, the VRF AC indoor units and the room control boards.
- e) Supply and fixing of 20 mm and 25 mm medium class PVC conduit with accessories in surface/recess, including cutting the wall and making good the same in the case of recessed conduit.
- f) Supply and laying of 75 mm dia heavy duty rigid PVC pipe as under-floor cable sleeve/duct to the centre-table position, including cutting the floor chase, bedding, drawing in of cable, refilling, sealing of ends and making good the floor finish.
- g) Supply and fixing of 6 pin 5/6A & 15/16A socket outlet boxes and of 20A, 240V SPN industrial type socket outlets with SP MCB in sheet steel enclosure for the VRF AC indoor unit power connections.
- h) Supply and fixing of single pole MCBs in the existing MCB distribution boards and in the workstation boards, complete with connections, testing and commissioning.
- i) Supply and drawing of Cat 6e LAN/Ethernet cable and supply and installation of gang boxes with dual-port face plates for the workstation network points.
- j) Supply and fixing of modular switches, 3 pin 5/6A socket outlets, modular blanking plates and GI modular boxes of 1/2, 6 and 12 module sizes for the 20 workstation boards, the room control boards and the master shut-off points.
- k) Supply, installation, testing and commissioning of 1200 mm sweep BEE 5-star BLDC ceiling fans with electronic fan regulators, 2x2 ft. 36W LED panel lights, LED profile light fittings for the above-cabinet/cove lighting, and recessed hydraulic pop-up table boxes.
- l) All incidental civil/electrical making-good, testing, commissioning and demonstration of proper functioning of the complete installation, as directed by the Engineer-in-Charge.

Detailed item-wise description, unit, and quantity are given in the Bill of Quantity (BOQ) enclosed. IIML reserves the right to alter, add, omit, or substitute any item or quantity as per site requirements.

3. **OWNER**

Indian Institute of Management, Prabandh Nagar, IIM Road, Lucknow-226013.

4. **ENGINEER/ENGINEER-IN-CHARGE**

Executive Engineer, IIM, or any person designated from time to time by the owner, and shall include those who are expressly authorized by him to act for and on his behalf for the operation of this contract.

5. **CONTRACT RATES**

The rates quoted and accepted for the execution of work at the IIM Lucknow Campus shall remain firm, fixed, and binding on the contractor for the entire duration of the contract. This shall include any extension of the contract period granted by the Institute under the same terms and conditions. No claim for escalation, revision, or adjustment of rates shall be entertained on any grounds whatsoever, including but not limited to an increase in the cost of taxes, duties, or any other input costs. The contractor shall be deemed to have taken all such factors into account when quoting the rates, and no additional financial liability shall accrue to the Institute during the contract period.

The contract price shall include the cost of all materials, labor, and plants, and GST, for the proper completion of the work to the entire satisfaction of the owner and in accordance with the technical specifications.

6. **COMMENCEMENT DATE**

The date of commencement of work shall be the date of issue of the Letter of Intent (LOI). The work shall be completed within 50 DAYS from the date of the award of the work/letter of intent, or acceptance of the work.

7. **PERIOD OF COMPLETION**

The period of completion shall be 50 days from the date of L.O.I. and in correspondence with proposed Civil Works.

8. **PAYMENT TERMS**

The contractor may prepare and submit the bill based on the work completed and measured jointly by the IIML engineer & contractor. The contractor will have to submit a user verification certificate in the prescribed format given by the Project Division, certified by the user department, for processing the bill. 05% retention money will be deducted from each bill and released upon completion of the 12-month defect liability period.

9. **TAX/DUTIES**

All taxes/duties, GST or any other taxes or levies, etc., payable to any authorities whatsoever shall be borne by the contractor, and the owner accepts no responsibilities or liability whatsoever on this account.

The rates shall remain firm and no enhancement/escalation on account of any statutory/other increases by Local Authorities, State/Central Government shall be entertained.

10. **TESTING OF MATERIALS**

Samples of various materials required for testing shall be provided free of charge by the Contractor. Testing charges, if any, shall be borne by the contractor. All other expenditures required to be incurred for taking the samples, conveyance, packing, etc., shall be borne by the contractor himself.

11. **AWARD OF WORK**

The work shall ordinarily be awarded to the L1 bidder, i.e., the bidder whose bid is found to be the lowest evaluated and responsive bid, subject to fulfillment of all technical, commercial, and eligibility requirements stipulated in the RFQ.

In the event that the lowest bidder (L1) fails to accept the award of work, does not turn up to commence the work within the stipulated time, or abandons the work after commencement, the Institute reserves the right to offer the work to the next lowest bidder (L2) at the rates quoted by L1. The L2 bidder shall be required to match the L1 rates and accept the work under the same terms and conditions. In case L2 declines to accept the work at L1 rates, the Institute may proceed further as per applicable procurement rules and guidelines.

12. **INSPECTION AND TESTING**

The IIML or his authorized representatives shall have full power to inspect the work or examine the material. Acceptance of any material shall in no way relieve the contractor of his responsibility for meeting the requirements of the specifications. The contractor shall afford and procure for the owner every facility and assistance to carry out such inspection/tests. The cost of any special tests and/or analyses not called for in this specification shall be borne by the contractor. After completion of the works, the complete electrical and networking installation shall be tested and its proper functioning demonstrated in the presence of the Engineer-in-Charge, and if any defect or deficiency is found, the same shall be rectified by the contractor, though it may require rework of any or all activities involved in the scope of work.

13. **LABOUR CAMP**

The contractors at their own risk and cost shall establish the Labor Camps outside the campus premises. No manpower of the contractor will be allowed to stay inside the complex. The contractor will have to make arrangements for staying/accommodation for his manpower outside the complex. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.

15. **RETENTION MONEY:**

The 05% shall be deducted from each running account bill or the contractor's final bill as Retention Money. The 05% Retention Money shall be released to the contractor upon satisfactory completion of the 12-month Defect Liability Period. If a successful Bidder fails to commence the work within 7 days of the date of issue of the Letter of Intent, the Institute may reject the award of the work and engage another agency to carry out the work.

17. **SUB-STANDARD MATERIALS**

Any material rejected by the owner shall be removed from the site within 48 hours of the issue of instructions to this effect by the owner. Failing which, the IIML shall have the right to get these removed at the cost of the contractor, and the contractor shall have no claim whatsoever in this regard.

18. **SAMPLES**

It shall be the contractor's responsibility to submit samples of the materials and any other items as determined by the owner.

19. **SPECIFICATION**

The contractor shall perform the work in accordance with the latest CPWD Specifications and as directed by the Engineer in charge.

20. **DEFECT LIABILITY PERIOD**

12 months from the virtual date of completion.

21. **SECURED ADVANCE**

No secured advance shall be paid.

23. **JURISDICTION**

The contractor shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of Lucknow only.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. TWO-PACKET (TWO-BID) SYSTEM

- a) The RFQ shall be submitted under a Two-Packet System consisting of: (i) Packet-I – Technical Bid and (ii) Packet-II – Financial Bid. Both packets shall be submitted together in a properly sealed and clearly marked outer cover as prescribed by the Institute.
- b) Packet-I – Technical Bid: The Technical Bid shall contain all eligibility, credential, statutory, technical, and supporting documents specified in this RFQ. The Technical Bid shall not contain any price, rate, amount, percentage or other financial information. Disclosure of financial information in the Technical Bid may render the bid liable for rejection.
- c) Packet-II – Financial Bid: The Financial Bid shall contain only the duly filled and signed Bill of Quantity (BOQ)/price schedule and the percentage rate quoted by the bidder, as applicable. The Financial Bid of only technically responsive/qualified bidders shall be opened and evaluated.
Note: Contractors shall submit a single packet with name of work mentioned on it and that packet shall be having two Separate Packets for each of the technical & financial bids (separate **packets shall be having their names written on it**) shall be provided. Failing to do so, the candidature shall be canceled.

2. MANDATORY ELECTRICAL LICENCE CONDITION

- a) Participation in this RFQ is **restricted to contractors/firms holding a valid Electrical Contractor License issued by the competent licensing authority for carrying out the electrical works** covered under this RFQ. The electrical works shall be executed, tested and certified by appropriately licensed/authorized personnel as required under applicable rules.
- b) The bidder shall submit in Packet-I a self-attested copy of the valid Electrical Contractor License showing the license number, issuing authority, category/class/scope and validity period, together with the latest renewal/validity endorsement, wherever applicable. The license shall remain valid throughout execution of the work. Where the license is held by an associated/authorized electrical contractor proposed to be deployed for this work, the bidder shall also submit the valid authorization/association document and an undertaking confirming deployment for the work.
- c) Failure to submit the required valid Electrical Contractor License and supporting documents shall render the Technical Bid non-responsive and the Financial Bid shall not be considered.

3. TECHNICAL BID – RELEVANT DOCUMENTS

The following documents shall be submitted in Packet-I (Technical Bid), duly signed/self-attested as applicable:

- a) Duly filled and signed technical/credential details of the bidder.
- b) GST Registration Certificate.
- c) PAN / Income Tax Permanent Account Number document.
- d) Work experience certificates/work orders not older than 3 years and having similar works as specified in this RFQ; maximum 3–4 such documents may be submitted.
- e) Documentary evidence of constitution/registration of the firm, wherever applicable.
- f) Signed and stamped copy of the complete RFQ, including General Terms and Conditions, Special Conditions, technical specifications and BOQ, confirming acceptance of all terms and conditions.
- g) Undertaking/declaration as prescribed in the RFQ confirming the correctness of information/documents and non-blacklisting/debarment.
- ❖ Any other document specifically required by the Institute/Engineer-in-Charge for establishing technical eligibility or statutory compliance.

4. TECHNICAL EVALUATION AND OPENING OF FINANCIAL BID

The Technical Bid shall first be scrutinized for eligibility, completeness, validity of the Electrical Contractor License, experience, statutory registrations and compliance with the technical requirements of the RFQ. Only bidders declared technically responsive/qualified shall be considered for opening of their Financial Bids. The Institute reserves the right to verify any

license, certificate, work order or other document from the issuing authority or concerned organization.

5. FINANCIAL BID

Packet-II (Financial Bid) shall contain only the completed BOQ/price schedule and the percentage rate quoted by the bidder. The quoted rates shall be inclusive of all costs, taxes, duties, labour, testing, commissioning and other obligations specified in the RFQ. No additional conditions, rebates or qualifications shall be inserted in the Financial Bid. Financial Bids of technically non-responsive bidders shall not be considered.

6. Where the work is found substandard, the contractor shall be liable to rectify it to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-Charge by either rectifying or replacing
7. If, at any time during the execution of the Works, any testing, inspection, or verification of any installation or works executed by the Contractor is required or deemed necessary by IIM/L, such testing, inspection, or verification shall be carried out by the Contractor at its own cost and expense, without any additional cost or liability to IIM
8. All signatures in RFQ documents shall be dated as well as all the pages of all sections of the RFQ document shall be initiated at the lower right-hand corner and signed wherever required in the RFQ papers by the Bidder or by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to sign on behalf of the Bidder before submission of the RFQ.
9. No mobilization advance will be paid to the contractor.
10. If the altered/additional or substituted work or any additional work is required to be as per the IIML requirement for which there are no established rates in the BOQ and Delhi Schedule of Rates, the same shall be payable as per the provision stated hereunder.
11. For similar items, the rates shall be derived from the nearest RFQ item.
12. If direct working out is not possible as mentioned in 4 & 5 above, the contractor shall be paid on the basis of the actual cost of material and labor cost plus 15% towards profit, supervision, overheads, establishment, plants, machinery, etc.
13. The rates quoted by the contractor and accepted by the Institute shall be firm and fixed for the above work, and no escalation shall be paid to the contractor in this account.
14. In case the Institute is not satisfied with the performance of the contractor or the contractor delays the work, the Institute is empowered to get the work completed by another agency and debit the expenditure on the contractor's account. No objection or claim whatsoever on this account will be entertained.
15. Rates given should be inclusive of all Central, State, and Local taxes, including Trade Tax on works contracts.
16. Rates shall be deemed, inclusive of payments of dues by the contractor to the labour in accordance with the prevailing labour laws.
17. The work is to be executed in accordance with the latest Central Public Works Department (C.P.W.D.) specifications & contractor is required to follow all the applicable labour laws as specified in the CPWD manual.
18. IIM reserves the right to curtail or enhance the scope of work either by deletion of certain items entirely or by reducing/increasing the quantities of certain items as required and reviewed by the Institute from time to time, and therefore, the final value of the work shall be worked out and paid to the extent of work actually carried out.
19. In case of defective works, the same shall be rectified by the Contractor at his cost.
20. The Contractor is not allowed to sublet the work back-to-back to another contractor.

21. IIM, Lucknow reserves the right to terminate the agreement even without giving notice in the event the performance of the contractor is not found satisfactory.
22. Income Tax as per the rules will be deducted from the bill, and the amount so deducted will be credited to the Income Tax authorities, and a certificate of the amount credited will be issued by the account section of IIM, Lucknow.
23. Prevailing Turnover Tax will be recovered as per Government rules if applicable.
24. The dispute, if any, will be referred to the Director, IIM, and his decision will be final and binding.
25. All disputes arising out of the order will fall under the jurisdiction of the Lucknow Court.
26. Prior intimation will have to be given to the Engineer-in-Charge/AE by the contractor if he proposes to work on Sundays or any other holidays. The additional cost of wages and any other cost by overtime or shift work shall be borne in full by the contractor.
27. The contractor/ firm/ company shall be responsible and shall bear all costs and losses if any institute assets/items/tanks/ property, etc., are found damaged.
28. The site shall be handed over to the Institute in working condition after satisfactory completion of the work. The unserviceable material shall be removed from the site and disposed of at the Junkyard.
29. The terms & conditions given in the quotation inviting notice are also part of the General Terms and Conditions.
30. All the conditions of GCC available on the IIML website will be applicable. Link <https://www.iiml.ac.in/sites/default/files/upload/tender/293037022gcc.pdf>
31. The contractor should strictly adhere to all the safety rules and regulations. The contractor shall be required to provide necessary safety arrangements to avoid any accidents. He shall be solely responsible for any accidents and payment of any compensation related to such accidents.
32. The contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Indian Institute of Management, Lucknow, against payments to be made under and for the observance of the laws aforesaid and the C.P.W.D. Contractor's Labour Regulations without prejudice to his right to claim indemnity from his sub-contractors.
33. Please follow the rule of security personnel at the main gate and the workplace.
34. For any site work, the contractor will have to follow the working schedule as per the academic and examination calendar of the Institute and the working condition of the building, as suggested by the Engineer-in-Charge. No compensation in this regard will be given.

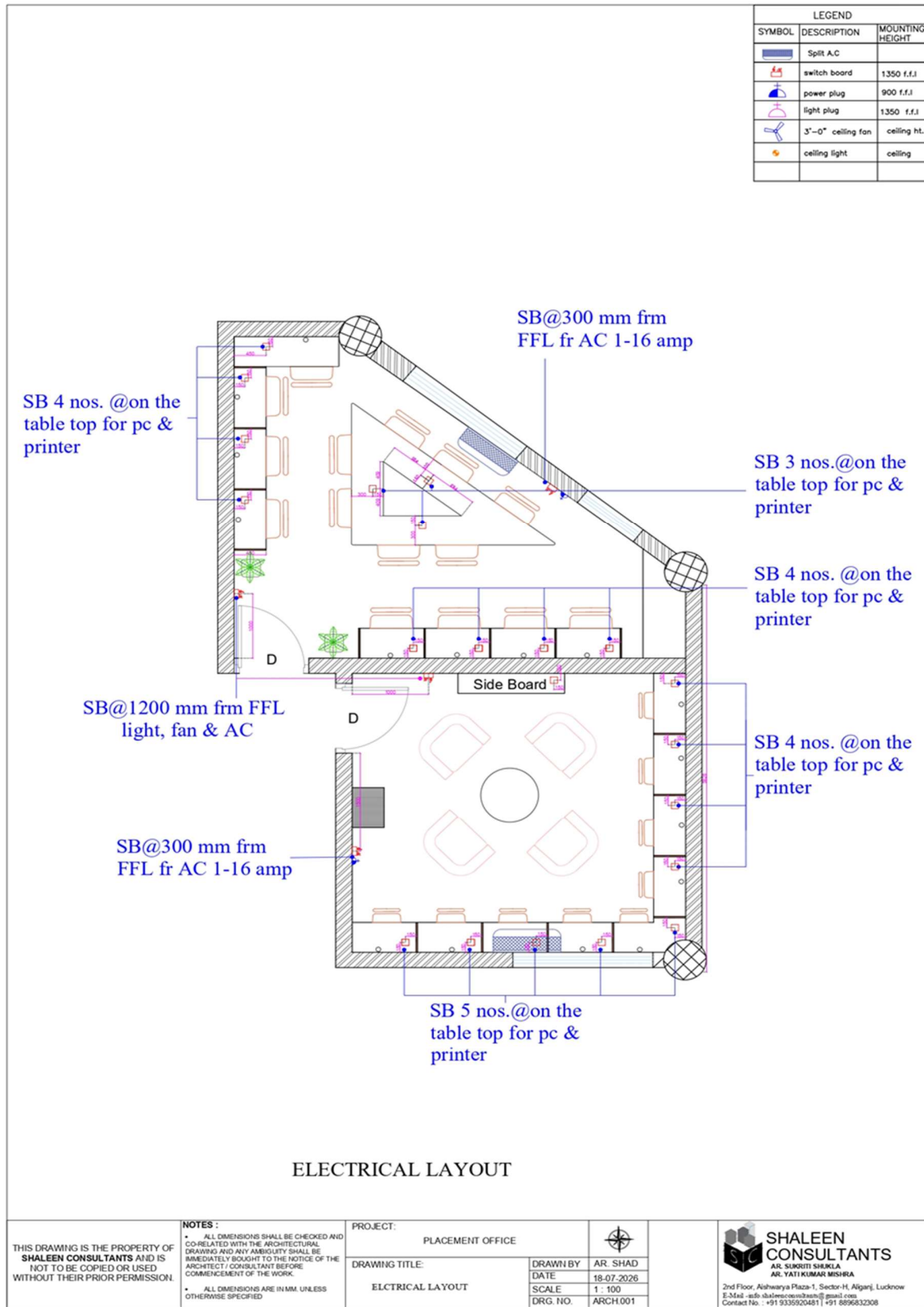
